Upon arrival to Camp you will be asked to sign your child in. At sign-in, you may be asked if your child has any **SYMPTOMS** and any **RISKS**. We may also check temperatures. Please review the SYMPTOMS and RISKS lists below so you are prepared to answer the questions.

SYMPTOMS

When signing your child in you will be asked “Does your child have any symptoms of COVID-19?” By answering no you acknowledge that in the last three days your child has not had:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fever or chills
- Muscle or body aches
- Sore throat
- Headache
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Runny or stuffy nose
- Fatigue
- Recent loss of taste or smell

RISKS

You will also be asked “Does your child have any of the risk factors associated with COVID-19?” By answering no you acknowledge that:

- Your child has NOT been in close contact with anyone with COVID-19 or symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14 days
- Your child has NOT traveled anywhere outside the 50 United States in the past 14 days
- Your child has NOT traveled to Rhode Island for a non-work-related purpose from another city, town, county, or state that currently has a stay-at-home restriction, a shelter-in-place restriction, or a similar restriction, declaration, or announcement due to a COVID-19 outbreak
- Your child has NOT been directed to quarantine or isolate by the Rhode Island Department of Health or a healthcare provider in the past 14 days

If you answer yes to either the **symptom** or the **risk** factor question your child will not be allowed to come to camp. If your child has a **fever** they will not be allowed to come to camp.
